Dick Carothers read a resolution of the City of Lilburn, Georgia approving and authorizing the execution, delivery and performance of a First Amendment to Intergovernmental Contract with the Lilburn Downtown Development Authority pertaining to the issuance of the Lilburn Downtown Development Authority amended and restated Promissory Note and the Lilburn Downtown Development Authority Promissory Note and further to authorize the Mayor to execute the following, including but not limited to the DDA Line of Credit & Term Loan:

1. Amended and Restated Promissory Note (reflecting a reduction in the line of credit from \$1.5 million to \$1 million)
2. Promissory Note (for the new \$550,000 loan)
3. First Amendment to the Intergovernmental Contract
4. First Amendment to the Assignment
5. Third Amendment to the Deed to Secure Debt
