8. AWARD OF CONTRACT

This contract will be an "Open End" type to provide for the requirements of the City of Lilburn on an as-needed basis. The quantities of items may be increased or decreased, and specific roads added or deleted as required to satisfy the needs of the City. Award will be made to the bidder submitting the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The City reserves the right to make such investigations as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform, and the bidder shall furnish to the City, all such information for this purpose as the City may request. The City reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such bidder fails to satisfy the City that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract.

9. CONTRACT TIME:

Contract will begin on the issuance date of the Notice to Proceed and continue through October 19, 2023. Contractor can schedule the work within this timeframe in the manner that is most cost-effective, though it is important that once any work has begun on a given street, progress must proceed promptly through completion. Failure to complete all required work under this contract by October 19, 2023 will result in the assessment of Liquidated Damages in the amount of one hundred (\$100.00) per calendar day for every day beyond this date.

10. RETAINAGE

No retainage will be held on this Project.

11. SITE EXAMINATION:

The Bidder is advised to examine all the locations of the work and to inform himself fully as to its conditions, the conformation of the ground, the character, quality and quantity of the products needed preliminary to and during the execution of the work; the general and local conditions and all other matters which can in any way affect the work to be done under the Contract. The estimated quantities are based on field run survey provided by the City of Lilburn; accuracy of this information shall be verified by the Bidder.

The quantities given in the proposal form and Contract are approximate only, being given as a basis for the comparison of bids. The City of Lilburn does not, expressly or by implication, agree that the actual amount of work will correspond therewith, and reserves the right to increase or decrease the amount of any class or portion of the work, or to omit portions of the work. All items of work will be paid for at the respective Bid Unit Prices for such work done and accepted by the City.

The Contractor is responsible for the location of above and below ground utilities and structures, which may be affected by the work. Failure to examine the work locations will not relieve the successful bidder of his obligation to furnish all products and labor necessary to carry out the provisions of his contract.

12. COMPLIANCE WITH OSHA STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS

The work connected with this Contract shall be performed in accordance with all applicable OSHA regulations and standards including any additions or revisions thereto until the job is completed and accepted by City of Lilburn.

13. MATERIALS

All materials furnished and/or installed by the Contractor shall be furnished only by Georgia Department of Transportation certified source and shall be within the limits, tolerances, formulae, etc., as established by the Georgia Department of Transportation.
